Authorization – Water Resources Development Act:

Kansas Citys Levees [KC, KS and KC, MO]: \$41,210,000 [federal share] included in H.R. 1495, which passed the House on 4/19/07 and the Senate on 5/16/07; the bill now awaits conference committee consideration.
